NH Fish and Game concurs with the recommendations and proposed actions, as outlined in the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) signed by the US Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and Eagle Creek Renewable Management, LLC (ECREM) on August 14th, 2014, regarding several hydroelectric facilities located in New Hampshire. These facilities include Mine Falls (FERC#3442) on the Nashua River, Gregg Falls (FERC# 3180) on the Piscataquog River, Webster-Pembroke (FERC# 3185) on the Suncook River and the Lakeport (FERC#6440), Lochmere (FERC# 3128), Clement (FERC# 2966) and Steven Mills (FERC# 3760) facilities on the Winnipesaukee River.

The Department appreciates the work that has been completed by the USFWS, ECREM and others to reach the actions outlined in the MOA, in order to advance the enhancement and protection of fish and habitat In addition, the Department agrees that the Low Impact Hydropower Institutes (LIHI) should include a provision acknowledging the applicants concurrence with implementing minimum flows and fish passage measures for herring and/or American eel as prescribed in the MOA, and to undertake such consultations, design development and construction in a timely manner
