Attached please find the NHB database check (NHB File ID: NHB 13-2219) for the Webster-Pembroke hydroelectric facility Dam (FERC Exemption No. 3185) located on the Suncook River in the towns of Pembroke and Allenstown, NH. The database check found the existence of the endangered Brook Floater and Blanding's Turtle within the project boundary as well as the threatened Bald Eagle. The dam is owned by the NH Water Resources Board and the hydroelectric project is operated by Eagle Creek Renewable Energy LLC in a strict run-of-the-river mode with minimum flows equal to 10 cfs through the 1,400 foot bypass reach

I've attached the project's FERC exemption as well as a Google Earth map of the project. Please let me know if you need any additional information in order to make a determination regarding the project's impact on the listed species.
