Essex Power Services, Inc. as the authorized agent of Eagle Creek Renewable Energy LLC, owner and operator of the Webster-Pembroke hydroelectric project (the "Project") located on the Suncook River in Allenstown, NH is pleased to inform you that it is in the process of submitting an application to the Low Impact Hydropower Institute ( <http://www.lowimpacthydro.org/> ) for the low impact certification of the Project. Condition G of the Project's application for low impact certification requires confirmation that the project is in compliance with the terms and conditions of its Exemption from Licensing issued by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission on February 24, 1983 and attached for your reference. The project's FERC Exemption does not contain any specific provision for recreational access however the project currently permits recreational access free or charge within a safe distance of the dam and the associated project works. Considerable amounts of angling and recreational boating and swimming occur in Irish Pond the project impoundment, and within a safe distance of the project structures. That being said, Eagle Creek Renewable Energy LLC would appreciate confirmation from you that your agency has no concerns about recreational access at the site and that the project permits recreational access free of charge within a safe distance of the project works.
