LIHI Hosts UNIDO-GEF Delegation

On June 11th, a delegation of Chinese hydro-industry owners, executives, and experts met with the LIHI team to learn about LIHI, its program, and Low Impact Certified hydropower. This diverse group represents the International Center on Small Hydro Power, a non-profit institution operating under the



profit institution operating under the auspices of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO).

The delegation saw four LIHI Certified sites over two days, and hosted a workshop at UMASS Lowell to discuss issues related to small hydropower in China. LIHI gathered industry experts to share their wealth of knowledge with the delegation, topics ranging from fish passage to dam safety. Their insights into the safe, responsible, and clean development of Low Impact Certified hydro were met with much discussion and shared learning throughout.


