

F. CULTURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION

The Cultural Resource Protection Criterion is designed to ensure that the facility does not inappropriately impact cultural resources. Cultural resources must be protected either through compliance with Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) license provisions, or through development of a plan approved by the relevant state or federal agency.

The Mahoning Creek Hydroelectric Project facility is in compliance with all requirements regarding Cultural Resource protection, mitigation and enhancement. Within the project's FERC license is a Historic Properties Management Plan (HPMP), which covers all relevant issues. Please also see Article 406 of the FERC License for further information.
