LIHI by the Numbers

In 2021, LIHI certified 11 new projects and recertified 27 projects. In total, there are 173 active LIHI Certificates across 292 facilities.

Overall, the dams & powerhouses are:

- In 24 states, on 99 rivers
- Include 4,210 MW of capacity
- Generate 16,230 GWh of electricity annually
- Steward over 1,100 miles of river





Certifications: What's New

Effective January 1, 2022, the following changes to the Certification process will be implemented:

Terms will be extended from 5 years to 10 once a project is certified under the 2nd edition handbook.

- Annual compliance reviews will be enhanced, and certain events will trigger a recertification mid-term.
- Effective January 1, 2022, LIHI has added a graduated**minimum fee** schedule for small projects. The new fee levels are outlined <u>here</u>.

Build Back Better Update

Due to hard work by proponents of the 21st Century Dams Act, a provision was included in the Senate draft of the Build Back Better plan. The provision would provide a 30% investment tax credit for environmental improvements at the nation's dams. Despite recent setbacks, we are hopeful that if the bill moves forward, this section will be retained if not expanded.
