ERRATA NOTICE

(July 15, 2008)

On June 25, 2008, the Director of the Commission's Office of Energy Projects issued an Order Issuing an Original License in the above-captioned proceeding, *City of Hamilton, Ohio*, 123 FERC ¶ 62,254 (2008). This errata notice makes a correction to the June, 25 2008, license order.

In license Articles 406, Freshwater Mussel Survey and Protection; 407, Wetland Survey and Protection; 408, Terrestrial Survey and Protection; and 409, Indiana Bat Protection Measure, the next to the last paragraph in each article includes the requisite consultation provisions for the respective article. As presently written, the articles require the licensee to survey and develop various protection plans in consultation with the Kentucky DEP. As clarified below, the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources (Kentucky DFWR) replaces the Kentucky DEP in Articles 406, 408, and 409. The Kentucky DFWR is added to Article 407.

The four articles are corrected as follows:

Article 406 – the first sentence of the next to last paragraph is modified to read, “The survey and protection plan shall be developed after consultation with the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources and the FWS.”

Article 407 – the first sentence of the next to last paragraph is modified to read, “The survey and wetland protection plan shall be developed after consultation with the Kentucky Department for Environmental Protection, Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources, FWS, and Huntington District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.”

Article 408 – the first sentence of the next to last paragraph is modified to read, “The plant survey and any protection measures for the Virginia mallow and any federally listed species shall be developed after consultation with the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service.”

Article 409 – the first sentence of the next to last paragraph is modified to read,
“The Indiana bat surveys and protection plan shall be developed after consultation
with the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources and the FWS.”
